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|  <p>1/19/06</p> | <p><u>Patient:</u> Ben</p> <p><u>Problem:</u> Degloving injury to Neuropathy to Self Mutilation 2 year duration. (Secondary to Broken back due to hit by car) Overweight, digits non movable, frozen, stilted gait</p> <p><u>Previous Therapies:</u> Routine wound care, including systemic antibiotics, e-collar, boots, bandage changes, home care for 2 years</p> |
|  <p>1/26/06</p> | <p><u>K Laser Protocols:</u></p> <p>Watts:2 Hz:100 Time:2 minutes</p> <p><u>Treatment Frequency:</u> 6 consecutive days per week for 30 days, every other day laser treatments were given through bandage.</p> <p><u>Additional Treatments:</u> weight management, manual therapy (passive range of motion with the digits), routine wound care,</p> <p><u>Medications:</u> Antibiotics, Neurontin</p> <p><u>Topical Medications:</u> Silvadine, Bio Dress, Hypergel 20% sodium chloride, Wound Care Product</p> |
|  <p>2/25/06</p> | <p><u>Outcomes:</u> Neuropathy under control, self mutilation has stopped and wounds are healing remarkably</p> <p><u>Prognosis:</u> Full recovery with some scarring</p> |
